POST: Emergency Awareness Trainer

BASED: At our state of the art airbase in Outmarsh, Semington, BA14 6JX,

with extensive travel around Wiltshire and Bath

SUMMARY:

We are Wiltshire and Bath Air Ambulance Charity. We provide critical medical care by land and air, across our communities.

We're here when you need us most, but in the nicest possible way, we hope you won't.

This role will be responsible for delivering sessions in our Emergency Awareness Training programme. The programme teaches the heroes of tomorrow skills to act in an emergency.

As directed by your manager, the trainer will lead sessions on making a 999 call, recovery position, CPR, AED use, choking and bleeding control.

We see this as an essential part of our wider mission in helping to save lives across Wiltshire, Bath and surrounding areas.

The role will involve the continuing growth of our education programme offered for primary, secondary and tertiary education establishments as well as to corporate and community supporters.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Schools Teaching and Learning

- Delivering training and education at schools in Wiltshire and Bath.
- Liaising with schools to offer the programme, working with the Front of House and Charity Support Coordinator.
- Adapting training to tailor sessions to the relevant age group.
- Adapting training for settings and individuals with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.
- Monitoring performance against agreed KPIs.
- Evaluating and updating the agreed framework of training and education programme annually.
- Working closely with the Emergency Awareness Training Manager and other senior managers to report annually to the Board of Trustees on the programme and its effectiveness.
- Ensuring that all training aides are suitable for the training package they are delivering and are cleaned and ready for use at the next training session.
- Reporting any faulty training aides or loss of aides to the Emergency Awareness Training Manager.

Community Training and Events

- Supporting the Charity's fundraising team through delivery of CPR demonstrations at Charity events.
- Working with fundraising and supporter engagement teams to promote engagement with the Charity through our education programme.

Corporate Training

 Carrying out corporate training programmes to the Charity's Business Club members and corporate supporters.

Other Duties and Responsibilities

- Promoting and upholding the Charity's Mission, Vision and Values in all aspects of work.
